Brimfield Civil War Monument

Brimfield, Massachusetts was one of the first towns to commemorate the Civil War. This beautiful monument was dedicated on July 4, 1866. Each section of the Cast Iron fence is attached by a cannon used during the Civil War. The decorative Cannon Cast Iron Fence that surrounds the monument was given to the Town by the owner of the then Brimfield Hotel, Silas Herring. The Cannon Cast Iron Fence and Sign were damaged by a motor vehicle crash in 2005. **Bartlett** restored this historic fence and sign to their original condition. This was done at no cost to the Town of Brimfield through Accident Recovery services provided by **Bartlett**.
